Our mission is to provide North Shore residents in need of furniture and household items, good quality used goods donated by community members fortunate enough to have a surplus of those things. For the last 10 years we have operated out of a small storage facility on Bewicke Avenue, but the lease for this space is coming to an end on October 31, and we need your help to find a new space for November 1 or earlier.

Our wish list includes:

- 800-1000 square feet
- On the North Shore, preferably in a central location
- Convenient to a bus route
- Heated, well-lit, secure
- An easily accessible, drive-up entrance that is large enough to accommodate furniture, such as couches, queen size mattresses
- A generous landlord who might provide a discounted rent to a grass roots not for profit that serves community members experiencing furniture poverty, and helps those who have surplus furniture to donate it to a good cause.

We serve clients of a number of North Shore social service organizations such as Hollyburn Family Services, Vancouver Coastal Health, North Shore Lookout Society, Harvest Project, and recently received a large donation of furniture from a well-known international furniture retailer to support our work.

We are able to issue a tax receipt for an in-kind donation of space, and would be happy to acknowledge support on our website, on social media, and in written material.
